# What are the Compact for Success Requirements? 

- Students need to be in the Sweetwater Union High School District continuously from grades $9^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$.
- Complete all the A-G courses required for CSU admissions.


| Courses | Number of years required |
| :--- | :--- |
| A) Social Science : World History, US <br> History, Government | 2 years |
| B) English 9-12 (ELD 7-8 only) | 4 years |
| C) Math: Algebra*, Formal Geometry*, <br> Intermediate Algebra, Integrated Math I*, <br> II, III, Finite Math, Math Analysis, Calculus | 3 years <br> $(4$ years recommended) <br> *can be taken in middle school |
| D) Science: Biology, Chemistry, Physics | 2 years <br> $(3$ years recommended) |
| E) Foreign Language* | 2 years <br> $(3$ years recommended) <br> *can be taken in middle school |
| F) Visual and Performing Arts | 1 year |
| G) College - Prep Elective | 1 year |

## Foreign Language

- Algebra and Geometry or Integrated Math taken in the $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade count for high school credits as well as meet university admissions subject requirements.
- Foreign Language taken in the $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade count for high school credit as well as meet university admissions subject requirements.

## Support from home

- Clear Math Remediation
- SAT - 550
- ACT - 23
- AP Calculus or AP Statistics Score of 3 or better
- EAP - Score of Exempt
- EAP - Score of Conditional Exempt - must be enrolled in an approved math class in Senior Year


## $4^{\text {th }}$ requirement...



- Clear English Remediation
- SAT - score of 500
- ACT - score of 22
- AP English Score of 3 or better
- EAP - Score of Exempt
- EAP - Score of Conditional Exempt - Must complete specific English class

## College tests...

- Obtain a minimum CSU Eligibility of 2900 for SAT or 694 for ACT


## $7^{\text {h }}$ requirement

- If you use your SAT score:
(High School GPA X 800)
+ (SAT Critical Reading + Math Score)
= Eligibility Index
- If you use your ACT score
(High School GPA X 200)
+ (10 X ACT Composite Score)
= Eligibility Index
- Meet all SDSU Admission/Enrollment deadlines

File application between October 1 and November 30
No "D" or "F" grades in Senior Year
Submit their intent to enroll by May $1^{\text {st }}$


- Nursing

> Majors not included in Compact

- GPA of 3.1
- Rest of requirements remain the same

- 44 credits to graduate from high school
- 30 hours of community services
